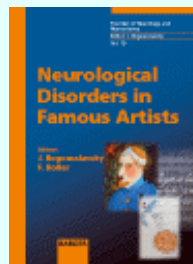

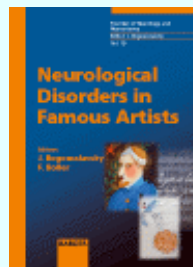

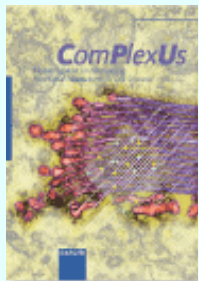

## **Subscriptions for Karger Journals**


### **Demand:**
